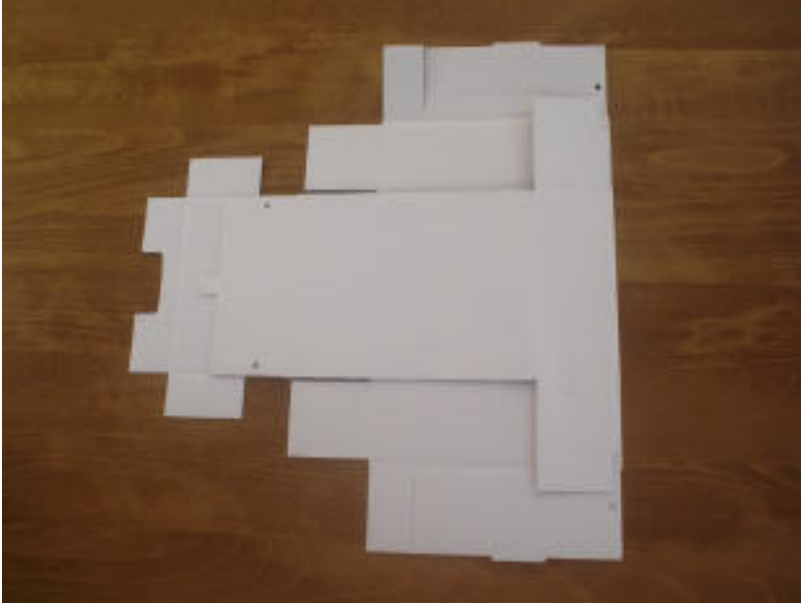
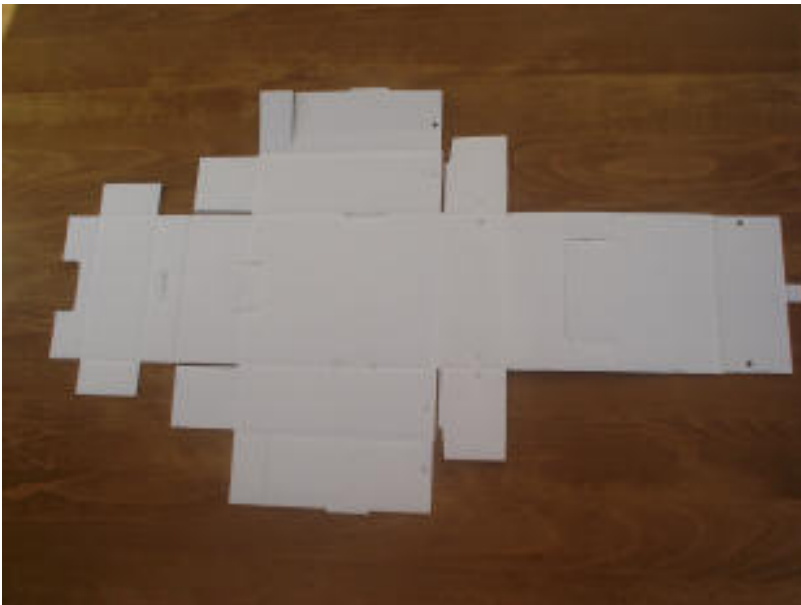


How to make up white boxes

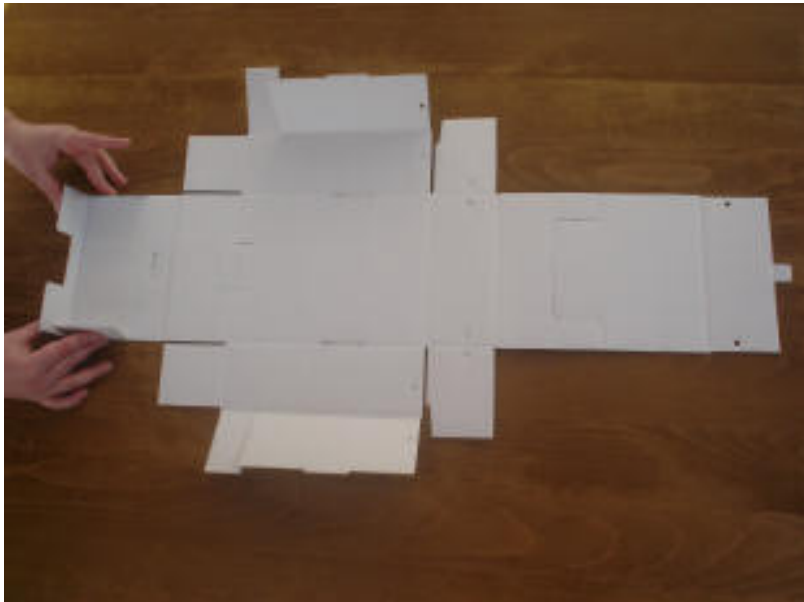
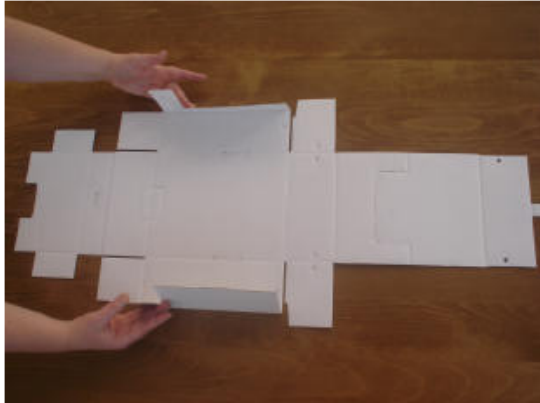
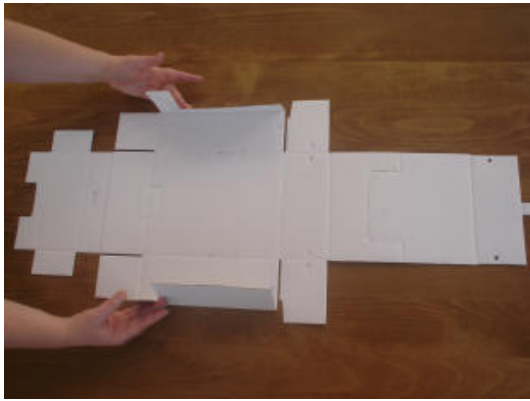
Place the box on a flat surface with the shiny side down.



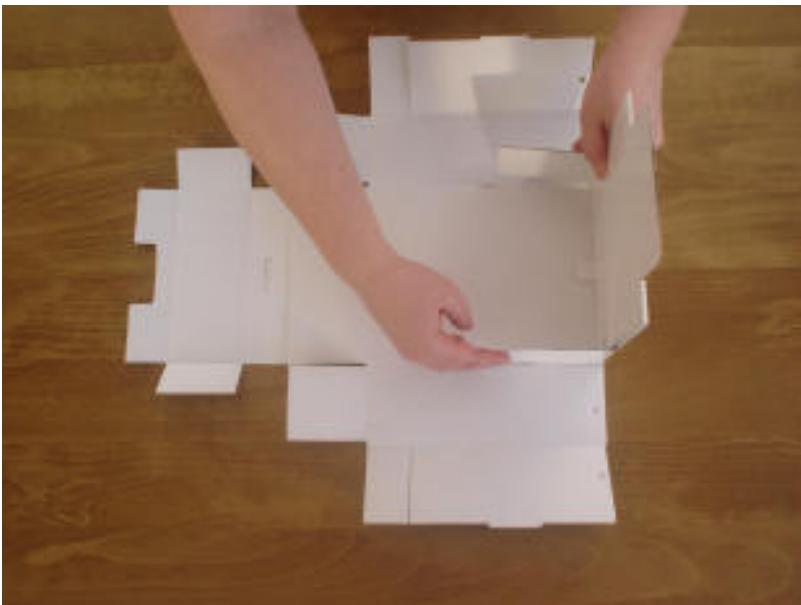
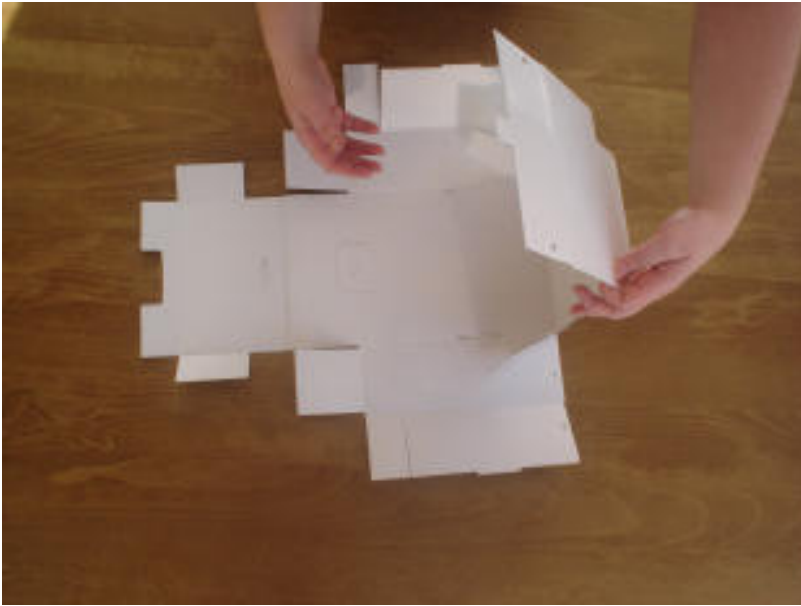
Open the box out.



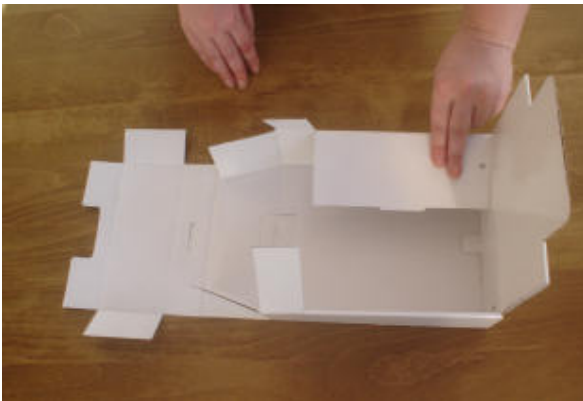
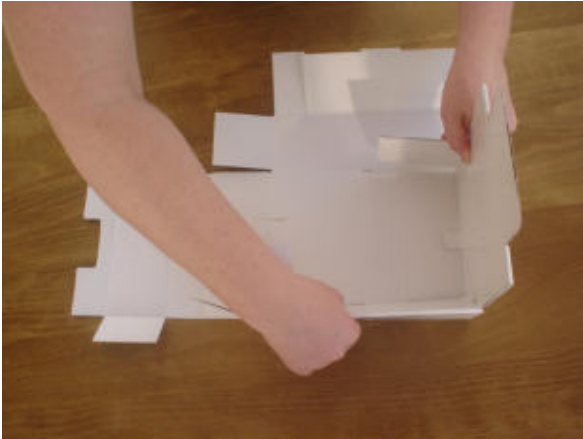
There are lines which is where the box folds. Press each of these before starting to make the box easier to work with



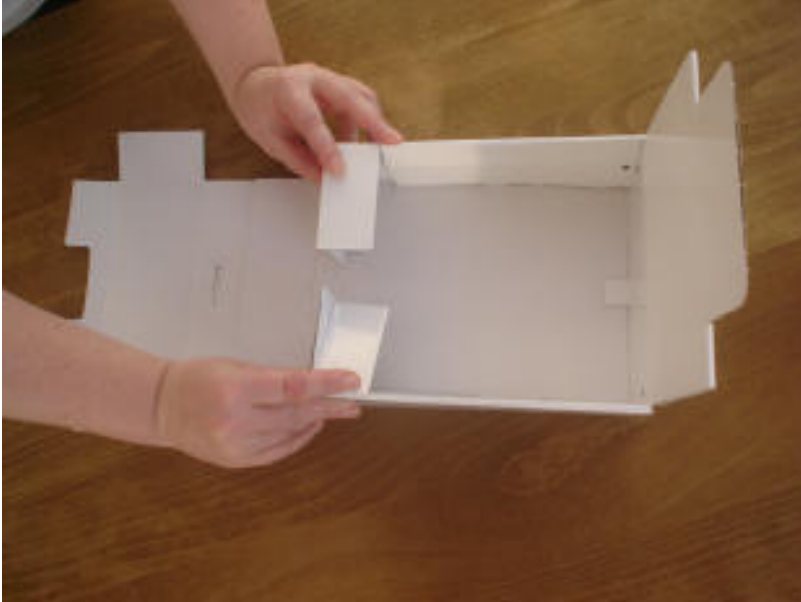
When you have pressed every crease loose the bit that sticks up and fold it in on itself.



Then take the two sides and fold them over the flaps that fold round from the piece you have just done.



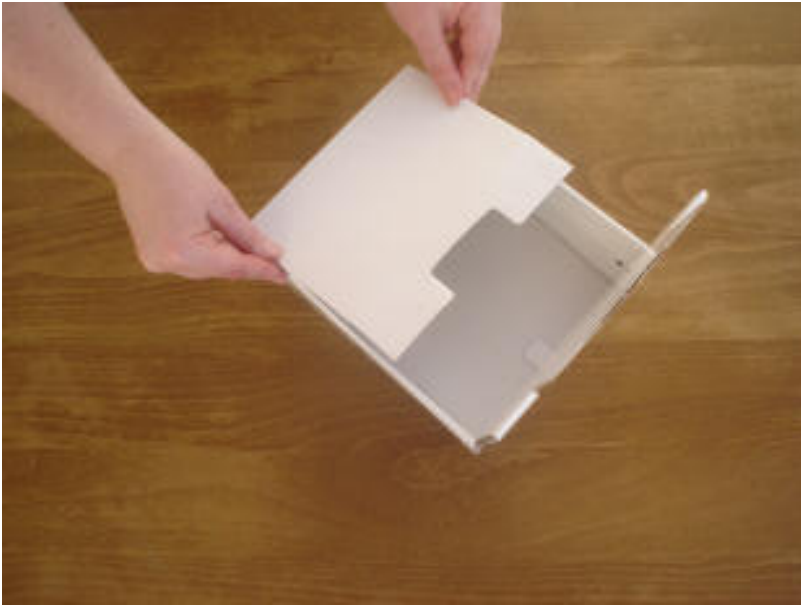
The box is well on its way now. Fold the next two edges as shown.



Raise the bit not yet folded to face the back of the box.



Turn the edges in and start to push this bit into the box.



Bend the very end bit under so it is flat to the base of the box and push. This part is really tough as you need to be firm.



Keep pressing till it is secure.
